At the end of the school year kindergarten teachers will inform each parent of his/her child's specific reading level. We recommend that students read at least 6 –10 books at the current and next level over the summer. It would be great to read even more titles!

Use this site to find books for summer reading. The books are leveled by letters. For example, under Kindergarten the levels are A – C, Grade One: C – I , and Grade 2: H – J. Check out titles at the library at your child's appropriate level and as your child makes progress over the summer you may want to move to the next level.

You can also use the alphabetical list to find the level of a specific title. For example, *Frog and Toad Are Friends*, under F is at the K reading level.
