Dress Code Announcements... With the change in temperatures, boys in K-4th grades must begin wearing their sweater vests with the formal uniform. Girls in grades K-4 wear a navy cardigan with the formal uniform. Girls in grades 5-6 wear a navy pullover sweater with the formal uniform. On days the formal uniform is not required, students may wear a Covenant School sweat shirt, hoodie or fleece jacket in the classrooms during the school day. **Other sweat shirts are not permitted.** Students may also wear red or navy sweater vests on days the formal uniform is not required. Students may, of course, wear heavier outerwear to school which must be left in the locker during the school day. Remember to label all clothing.
